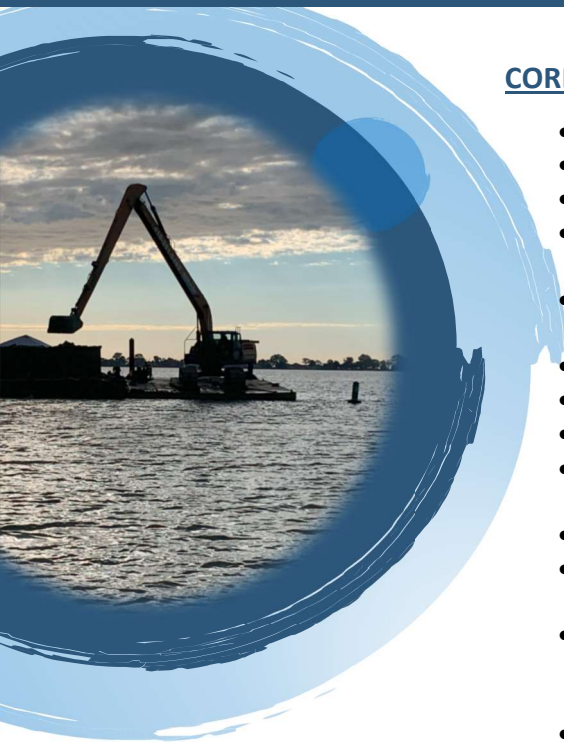

4. Perform construction inspections and provide owner's representation services on projects where Littoral is contracted to oversee work in the marine/maritime environments.
5. Ability to cross support field construction crews with maritime based construction operations on an as needed basis in an all-hands-on deck approach!
6. Prepare construction project deliverables including work plans, submittal packages, RFI's, daily reports, and assist with project management activities.
7. Support the tracking of prospective work, preparation of proposals/estimates, and aid in the marketing of the company.
8. Conduct field work including site inspections, surveys, and construction observations/reporting.
9. Prepare and present technical content to clients and the public.
10. Prepare and submit regulatory permit applications.
11. Interact with clients and regulatory agencies.
